

The speed rating of any tyre is a measurement of the top safe speed the tyre can carry a load under specified conditions. It is also an indication of how the tyre will handle at lower speeds. A higher rated tyre will give you better traction and improved steering response – even at 50mph. You will find this rating on the sidewall of your tyre, as part of the tyre sizing number.

Q	=	99 MPH, 160km/h
R	=	106 MPH, 170km/h
S	=	112 MPH, 180km/h
T	=	118 MPH, 190km/h
U	=	124 MPH, 200km/h
H	=	130 MPH, 210km/h
V	=	149 MPH, 240km/h
Z	=	149 MPH, 240km/h and over
W	=	168 MPH, 270km/h
